# Waste

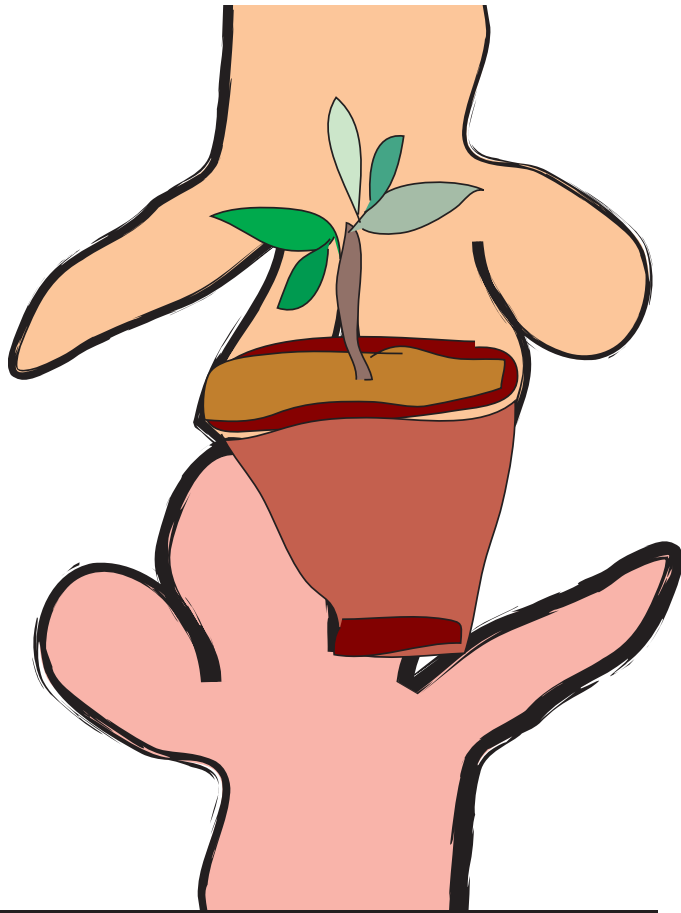
1. Create a "No Waste" program for the cafeteria, lunch boxes and school events.

5. Have a 'Clean Up the Trash Day' in the neighborhood surrounding your school.

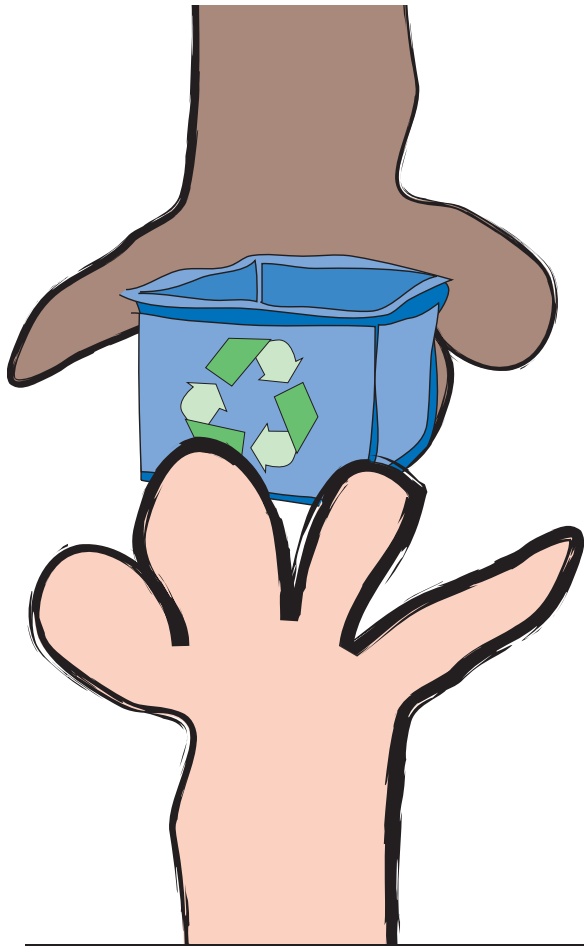
